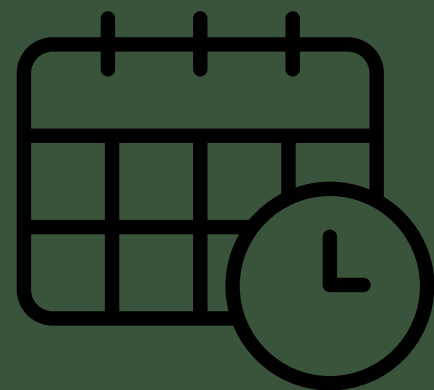

The Niumatou Site, located in Qingshui District, Taichung City, is considered one of Taiwan's representative Neolithic sites with significant archaeological value.



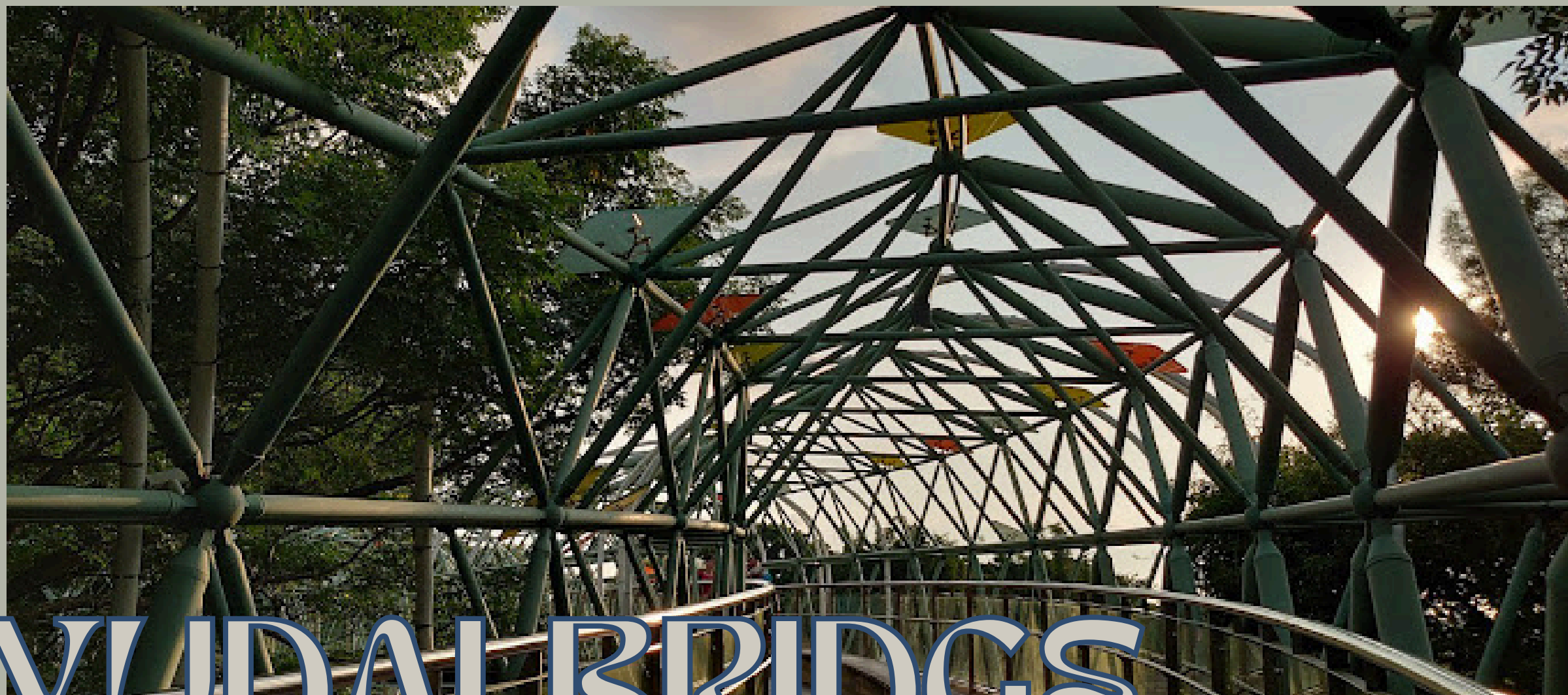
## DISCOVERY AND EXCAVATION:
