



The Niumatou Site, located in Qingshui District, Taichung City, is considered one of Taiwan's representative Neolithic sites with significant archaeological value.



DISCOVERY AND EXCAVATION:

Multiple excavations have unearthed a large number of artifacts, including pottery, stone tools, bone tools, and human remains.
